

BANGALORE TO MELKOTE

MELKOTE- CHELUVANARAYANA SWAMY TEMPLE:

An ancient temple means a fort on the top translating from the Kannada language where 'Melu' is top and 'Kote' is a fort. A popular pilgrimage destination in Karnataka also known as Thirunarayanapuram is built on a rocky hill called Yadugiri. According to historians, in the 12th century, the great Vaishnava saint, Sri Ramanujacharya lived here for 14 years and thus it came into the notice and became an important centre for Vaishnava. However, the temple existed even before Sri Ramanujacharya visited the place.

AKKA TANGI KOLA:

It is believed that these stepped ponds are created by two sisters. These two stepped ponds are excavated side by side with a walk way between them. The steps are paved neatly with granite stones. A Hanuman Temple and Kulasekara Alwar sannidhis are built on the banks. The water in one of the tank / pond is potable the other can be used for washing clothes and other purposes. The exact period of excavation is not known.

KERE THONNUR:

Kere Thonnur is a well-known tourist spot because of its green paddy fields, ancient temples and twin lakes. Many Kannada films were shot in this village and the adjacent village of Shingapoore. Keretannur lake is famous.

NAMBINARAYANA SWAMY TEMPLE:

Nambinarayana Swamy temple, Thondanur, Karnataka, is located 36 km west of Mandya and 38 km north of Mysore, on the southern slope of a small hillock called Yadugiri. Built in early 12th century CE by Hoysala king Vishnuvardhana (Bittideva), this 900+ year old marvel follows Chola architecture. 50 pillars adorn the Maharanga mandapa. The navaranga is richly carved and pillars embellished with motifs of flowers and beads. The deity that's 182 cm tall is said to be more than 5,500 years old, dating back to Dwapara Yuga.

KRS BACKWATER:

The Blue Lagoons or the KRS backwaters, has emerged as a must-see destination for most tourists.
