DAY 01:

ARRIVAL AT PUNE (AFTERNOON) & SIGHTSEEING BY FLIGHT / TRAIN/BUS Meal: Lunch | Dinner



After breakfast, check out from the Pune hotel

After breakfast, proceed for sightseeing

Visit Gateway of India: Start your day at this monumental structure, which holds deep historical significance as it commemorates the arrival of King George V and Queen Mary to India in 1911. Discuss Mumbai's colonial past and its role in India's independence.

Elephanta Caves: Take a boat ride to Elephanta Island and visit the rock-cut caves dedicated to Hindu gods. Explore ancient Indian art, sculptures, and learn about the religious significance of these caves.

Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Terminus (CST): Visit this UNESCO World Heritage site, a splendid example of Victorian-Gothic architecture. Learn about the history of the railway system in India and its economic importance.

Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Vastu Sangrahalaya (Prince of Wales Museum): Explore this museum, which houses an extensive collection of ancient sculptures, artifacts, and artwork from India's rich cultural heritage.

Lunch: Enjoy a meal at a local restaurant with traditional Maharashtrian food. Dhobi Ghat: Visit the open-air laundry (Dhobi Ghat) where thousands of clothes are washed daily. Discuss the traditional practices and the intersection of old and modern urban life in Mumbai.

Marine Drive and Chowpatty Beach: Finish the day with a visit to Marine Drive and Chowpatty Beach. Enjoy the sea breeze while discussing Mumbai's coastal development, urbanization, and its role as a global economic hub. Overnight stay at Mumbai
