- Bayon Temple (54 smiling stone faces)
- Baphuon Temple & Phimeanakas Temple
- Elephant Terrace & Preah Palilay
- Ta Prohm Temple ("Tomb Raider" temple with tree roots)
- Angkor Wat - World's largest religious monument

 **NEP 2020 Learning:** Khmer Empire history, Hindu-Buddhist architecture, UNESCO World Heritage

DAY 3: GRAND CIRCUIT - TEMPLE EXPLORATION




- Angkor Thom & Angkor Wat (different perspectives)
- Preah Khan Temple
- Neak Poan (island temple in water)
- Banteay Srei (Pink Temple - finest stone carving)

 **NEP 2020 Learning:** Ancient engineering, stone carving techniques, religious symbolism

DAY 4: PHNOM KULEN - SACRED MOUNTAIN




- Phnom Kulen Mountain ("Mountain of 1,000 Lingas")
- Sacred river bed carvings
- Preah Ang Thom (Giant Reclining Buddha)
- Kulen Waterfalls (swimming opportunity)
- Scenic mountain experience

 **NEP 2020 Learning:** Sacred geography, Hindu symbolism, natural water sources, mountain ecology

DAY 5: TONLE SAP LAKE & TRANSFER TO PHNOM PENH




- Tonle Sap Lake (Largest freshwater lake in Southeast Asia)
- Kompong Phluk (Floating village exploration)
- Observe stilt houses and fishing communities
- Overland transfer to Phnom Penh (capital city)
- Overnight stay at Phnom Penh

 **NEP 2020 Learning:** Aquatic ecosystems, floating village life, sustainable fishing, rural communities

DAY 6: PHNOM PENH CITY TOUR – ROYALTY & TRAGEDY



- Royal Palace (Khmer architecture) & Silver Pagoda
- Independence Monument & National Museum
- Toul Sleng Genocide Museum (S-21 Prison)
- Killing Fields of Choeung Ek

 **NEP 2020 Learning:** Cambodian genocide history, human rights, resilience, peace education, royal heritage

DAY 7: DEPARTURE FROM PHNOM PENH




- Transfer to Phnom Penh Airport
- Departure for return journey to Bangalore
- Memories of ancient Khmer civilization
