DAY 4	Alleppey → Kochi Departure (83km / 3hrs)

ARRIVAL KOCHI & TRANSFER TO MUNNAR

Distance: 126 kms | Duration: Approx 5 hrs

Upon arrival at Kochi Airport or Railway Station, you will be greeted by our representative. Board the bus for a scenic transfer to Munnar, a hill station located in the Western Ghats known for its rolling hills and tea plantations.

Activity: Observe the change in vegetation and climate as you ascend from the coast to the hills.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Overnight: Stay at Hotel in Munnar

MUNNAR SIGHTSEEING - LEARNING IN THE HILLS

Theme: Biodiversity, Industry & Physics

After a wholesome breakfast, proceed for a full day of experiential learning and sightseeing.

- **Tea Museum:** Understand the history of tea plantations, learn the industrial process of manufacturing from plucking to packaging.
- **Echo Point:** Practical demonstration of sound wave reflection (Physics) and environmental education.
- **Mattupetty Dam:** Learn about water resource management and hydroelectric power generation.

Learning Outcome: Understanding the balance between industrial development and ecological preservation.

MUNNAR TO ALLEPPEY - HOUSEBOAT EXPERIENCE

Distance: 168 kms | Duration: Approx 6 hrs

Breakfast at 7:30 AM followed by checkout. Drive towards Alleppey, the "Venice of the East".

Activity: Alleppey Backwaters Houseboat Ride

Experience the unique ecosystem where fresh water meets the sea. A lesson in:

- **Inland Water Transport:** How waterways serve as main roads.
- **Sustainable Tourism:** Impact of tourism on fragile ecosystems.
- **Local Livelihoods:** Coir making and paddy cultivation below sea level.

Overnight: Stay at Hotel/Resort in Alleppey

Distance: 83 kms | Duration: Approx 3 hrs

Breakfast at 8:00 AM. Check out from the hotel and transfer to Kochi Airport/Station for your return journey. Depart with bags full of memories and minds full of new knowledge.
