# DETAILED ITINERARY

## DAY 1

### Arrival in Jaipur

**Focus:** Introduction to Rajasthani Culture & Architecture

Upon arrival at Jaipur Airport or Railway Station, meet our representative and transfer to the hotel. After check-in and freshening up, proceed to visit the magnificent **Birla Mandir** made of pure white marble. Later, explore the vibrant **Local Market** to witness traditional crafts and textiles.

## DAY 2

### Jaipur Local Sightseeing

**Focus:** History, Astronomy, and Fort Architecture

After breakfast, embark on a full-day guided tour. Visit the royal **City Palace** and the UNESCO World Heritage site **Jantar Mantar** (observatory). Photo stop at the iconic **Hawa Mahal** (Palace of Winds). In the afternoon, explore the majestic **Amber Fort** and conclude the evening with a spectacular Sound & Light Show.

# Continuing the Journey...


## DAY 3

### Jaipur - Pushkar - Ajmer - Jodhpur

**Focus:** Religious Harmony & Geography

**Distance/Time:** Approx. 334 kms / 6 hrs

Depart after breakfast. En-route visit the holy **Brahma Temple** in Pushkar and the revered **Ajmer Sharif Dargah** in Ajmer, symbolizing India's syncretic culture. Continue the drive to the "Blue City," Jodhpur. Check-in upon arrival.

 **Meals:** Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

 **Overnight:** Jodhpur

## DAY 4

### Jodhpur - Jaisalmer

**Focus:** Royal Heritage & Desert Ecosystem

**Distance/Time:** Approx. 273 kms / 5 hrs

After breakfast, visit the grand **Umaid Bhawan Palace Museum** to see artifacts of the royal family. Proceed towards the "Golden City," Jaisalmer. Experience the shift in landscape as you enter the Thar Desert region. Check-in to your desert camp/hotel.

**Meals:** Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

 **Overnight:** Jaisalmer (Camp)

DAY 5

## Jaisalmer Local Sightseeing

**Focus:** Medieval Architecture & Folk Culture

Morning sightseeing of the living fort, **Golden Fort (Sonar Quila)**, and the intricate stone carvings of **Patwa Haveli**. In the evening, drive to **Sam Sand Dunes**. Enjoy camel rides, a cultural program with folk music/dance, and a bonfire dinner at the camp.

 **Meals:** Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

 **Overnight:** Jaisalmer (Desert Camp)

DAY 6

## Departure

**Focus:** Reflection & Return

**Distance/Time:** Approx. 264 kms / 5 hrs

After breakfast, check out from the camp. Drive back to Jodhpur and drop off at Jodhpur Airport or Railway Station for your return journey home, carrying memories of royal Rajasthan.
