Sketch Itinerary

Day	Activity Summary
Day 1	Arrival in Bangalore & Transfer to Coorg (approx. 297 kms / 6 hrs). Visit Raja's Seat.
Day 2	Coorg Local Sightseeing: Abbey Falls, Raja's Tomb, Coffee Plantation Tour, Madikeri Market.
Day 3	Transfer Coorg to Mysore. Visit Mysore Zoo, Mysore Palace & Brindavan Gardens (Musical Fountain).
Day 4	Transfer Mysore to Bangalore. Visit Bangalore Palace & ISKCON Temple.
Day 5	Drop to Bangalore Airport/Railway Station for return journey.

 **Educational Focus:** This itinerary balances *History* (Palaces), *Ecology* (Coorg Plantations/Zoo), and *Culture* (Local Markets/Temples), perfectly aligning with experiential learning goals.

Detailed Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival in Bangalore & Transfer to Coorg

 297 km / 6 hrs  Lunch, Dinner  Overnight: Coorg

Arrival at Bangalore Airport/Railway Station in the morning. Board the coach for a scenic drive to Coorg, the "Scotland of India." Upon arrival, check in to the hotel. In the evening, visit **Raja's Seat**, a garden with spectacular sunset views over the hills.



Day 2: Coorg Local Sightseeing

 Nature & Agriculture  Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner  Overnight: Coorg

After breakfast, proceed for a full day of sightseeing.

- **Abbey Falls:** Witness the beauty of the cascading waterfalls nestled in coffee estates.
- **Raja's Tomb:** Explore the Indo-Saracenic architecture of the royal tombs.
- **Coffee Plantation Tour:** An educational walk through a plantation to learn about coffee cultivation and processing.
- **Madikeri Market:** Evening visit to the local market to see local spices, honey, and chocolates.

Day 3: Coorg to Mysore Sightseeing

 Heritage & Wildlife  Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner  Overnight: Mysore

Early breakfast and checkout by 8:00 AM. Drive to Mysore.

- **Mysore Zoo:** Visit one of the oldest and most well-maintained zoos in India (includes Buggy Ride).
- **Mysore Palace:** Explore the opulent royal residence of the Wadiyar dynasty.
- **Brindavan Gardens:** Evening visit to KRS Dam to witness the famous Musical Fountain show.

Check in to the hotel in Mysore for dinner and overnight stay.

After breakfast, check out and drive to Bangalore.

- **Bangalore Palace:** Visit this Tudor-style palace inspired by Windsor Castle.
- **ISKCON Temple:** Experience the spiritual ambiance and architecture of this magnificent temple on Hare Krishna Hill.

Check in to the hotel in Bangalore. Dinner and overnight stay.
