



POTTERY ARTISAN DAY EXPERIENCE [EDUCREATE TRIP] School To Pottery Venue

UNIQUE EXPERIENCE & LEARNING OBJECTIVES:

Students will immerse themselves in the ancient art of pottery, developing fine motor skills, creativity, patience, and artistic expression. This comprehensive program introduces students to both wheel throwing and hand-building techniques through hands-on workshops led by certified pottery instructors and practitioners. Each activity promotes mindfulness, concentration, and tactile learning while encouraging students to explore clay as a medium for personal creativity and cultural appreciation. Students will learn fundamental pottery techniques including pinching, coiling, slab building, and wheel throwing, creating their own unique pieces to take home.

WORKSHOP STRUCTURE:

- Batch Organization: 100 students divided into 4 batches of 25 students each (Batch A, B, C & D)
- Session Format: 90-minute intensive hand building workshops + 10-minute wheel throwing side sessions
- Learning Approach: Progressive skill building with immediate application and personalized guidance
- Workshops: Simultaneous sessions with 1 master instructor and 4 assistant guides (5 instructors total)
- Take-Home Creations: Students create unique models
